Answer all the following questions:-

- 52. Give detailed introductions to SIX out of seven of the following and include notated examples and/or illustrations as appropriate:
- Murchana, Naad, Devotional song, Classical song, Semi-classical/light songs, Harmonium, Taal. (30 marks)
- 53. What is Layakari and what is Laya? Explain in detail with examples which must include Rupak Taal notated in Tigun. (15 marks)
- 54. What is Raag and what is Thaat? Explain their similarities and differences. Provide notated examples for both. (15 marks)

Answer TWO of the following questions. Each question carries 15 marks:-

- 55. Name 6 Gharanas. Choose one of those Gharanas and give a life sketch of a living artist from that Gharana and describe the main features of his/her style of singing.
- 56. Who was Annapurna Devi? Provide a life sketch of her and describe her performance style.
- 57. Describe Naghma and explain when and how is it used. Provide notated examples to support your answer.
